## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market) – Auctioneer Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603

### 329 Prime Cattle

The largest entry so far in 2008 met a very firm trade throughout, with best quality sorts holding values easily with perhaps second quality cattle a little easier bought. The usual buying contingent were around the ring, producing competitive bidding and an overall average of 129p/kg resulted.

Shapely cattle purchased for both wholesalers or butcher's readily sold with steers selling to 156p/kg on two occasions, with heifers passed 160p on four occasions topping at 165p/kg. There were more runs of suckler-bred bullocks this morning, with the heaviest (i.e. above 620kg) seeing the benefit of Farm Assurance. Best butchers heifers were not too plentiful.

A very mixed bag of bulls once again, with very few well finished Continentals forward. Two sold above 150p to a high of 158p for 530kg. Holsteins averaged 103.5p/kg selling to 120p/kg.

### 102 Over Thirty Month Cattle

96 Cows O.T.M. Cows sold to average 93p/kg

A flying trade once again with some better meat cows forward. Genuine Limousin cows sold to 128.5p for 690kg, with plenty of Grade 1 cows between 115 & 120p/kg. Grade 2 cows i.e. best Holsteins and average sucklers sold from 95-110p/kg, with Holsteins to 101.5p, and many dairy cows in the 90 pence's. Grade 3 steakers very dear once again with nothing below 80p/kg. Boners sold well passed 70p on most occasions except for big bellied milkers with full udders and no meat.

4 O.T.M. steers sold to 130p for 614kg Limousins and 129.5p for 508kg.

1 Belgian Blue Stock Bull sold to 80p with limited shape for 818kg

### 251 Clean Cattle

83 steers sold to an overall average of 133p/kg. Non FABBL steers sold to 156p for 524kg Lims from Guy Davies with FABBL beasts to the same for John Evans 650kg Limousin. Mr Evans sold 4 others from 146-147p/kg for 624-698kg. 620kg Limousins to 151p from IGC Morris. 586kg Lims to 147.5p from Richard Preece. 622kg Blues to 146p from David Froggatt, 598kg Lims to 145.5p from Sam Jones. "Off centre" dairy bred cattle a little easier to buy today with these perhaps 3-5p less in some cases.

168 heifers sold to an overall average of 131p/kg. Some superb Blondes from the Kinnish stable sold to 165p for 454kg and 163p for 524kg. 482kg Lims to 164p, 440kg to 154p and 488kg to 158p all from Miss Kirkham. 472kg Lims from Ray Bason to 160p with 546kg to 155p from the same home. IGC Morris sold a cracking 604kg Blue to 160p/kg (£955.40) and other Lims to 156p for 444kg & 460kg. 612kg Blondes to 156p (£954.72) from Guy Davies. 608kg Limousins to 155p (£942.40) from Dave Preece. Numerous others realised on or above 150p/kg.

### 79 Young Bulls ov. av. 125p/kg

The entry included 23 Holsteins and large runs of ultra plain Continental bulls.

530kg Blondes crosses sold to 158p from Bob Beaman, 584kg Lims to 150p from Henry Yates. A useful run of Lims from Mulberry

Homes sold to 149p/kg, 148p/kg, 147p/kg & 146p/kg for 522kg, 574kg, 508kg, & 502kg. 546kg Lims to 145p/kg again from Bob Beaman with 508kg Charolais to 145p and 628kg to 142.5p both from Rob Hartley first in the draw today. 666kg Charolais to 142p from Ian Moreton (£945.72).

Holstein bulls averaged 104p/kg and sold to 120p & 118.5p from Roger Cantrill. Glyn Breeze sold to 117p. 80 pence was bottom book today.
