Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

189 Prime Cattle

An improved trade with all Monday centres reporting the opposite. Decent lean cattle sold dearer with over fat and/or bad percenting sorts still in slower demand. The normal ring of buyers attended providing plenty of competition on all classes of cattle.

Shapely supermarket beasts sold particularly well with steers selling to 186p/kg and £1190.40 per head. Butchers heifers much dearer and sold to 198p/kg and £1033.60. Cattle with less shape but well-fed with lean cover saw a good trade, with little below 140p/kg unless with belly.

Bull trade took a step forward also with Continentals selling to 179p/kg for export quality with £1202.04 top price per head. Holsteins sold to the normal buoyant trade to a high of 147p/kg, with the Black and White bulls on show not the quality of recent sales.

28 Over 48 Month Old Cattle

702kg Belgian Blue crosses sold to 133p/kg, with 536kg Limousin to 127p/kg and 572kg to 122p/kg. 740kg meat Holsteins sold to 117p/kg. All Holsteins well above £1/kilo unless very plain boners selling around the 65p/kg mark!

Meat Hereford stock bulls 1032kg to 116p/kg (£1197.12).

42 steers sold to average 155p/kg. 612kg and 582kg Blues to 186p/kg and 185p/kg both from Max Preece. 506kg Limousins to 184p/kg from Neil Perkins. 586kg Blondes and 612kg Charolais to 177p/kg from Millichamp Bros and Jim Thomas respectively. Non-FABBL Herefords to 132p/kg from Henry Lewis with Richard Ince's Holsteins to 129p/kg. Angus to 145p/kg from Tim Davies. The ewes this week dearer than ever to a top price of £93 for Continental ewes – several over £90 and North Country Mules to £75.

Lean ewes exceptionally dear to £60 Mules, £67 Suffolks and fit horned ewes to £42.50. Rams to £80 for Suffolks, £75 Texels.

904 Hogs

A firm trade for hogs once again dearer than Monday, with properly finished hogs to 189p/kg. Export weights realising over 180p/kg on several occasions, with a top price per head of £90.40.

Heavy hogs a very similar trade to last week with 56.5kg at 160p/kg.

Light weights to 168p/kg for 29.5kg, with lean light weights dearer as the sale progressed.

834 Spring Lambs

The largest entry of lambs to date this season and several firms purchasing lambs for the first time this year.

A sale average of 209p/kg to 240p/kg Texel lambs from AG Kirton, with 38kg to 42kg lambs achieving the higher prices per kilo.

Heavy spring lambs 43kg+ proving hard to sell with customers keen to avoid over fat sheep, even so a top price of £96 per head for 40kg.
