## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 246 Prime Cattle

Trade took a step forward once again with numbers tight everywhere although there were a few more forward in Bridgnorth this morning. An overall average of just above 156p/kg, with some better quality cattle forward. A full buyer contingent produced competitive bidding from start to finish.

Best quality cattle although more plentiful held values easily with second quality sorts dearer. Steers sold to 185p/kg for 446kg, with heavy bullocks to 180p/kg and £1226.82 per head. Retail heifers swayed passed 190p/kg on two occasions to 195p/kg with heavy heifers to £1142.76. There were more clean cattle above £1000 than recent sales.

Handy Continental bulls sold to 180p/kg with heavy bulls to £1136.66. Many sold well above £1000 in this department also. Red and white Swedish bulls to 140p/kg. Friesians to 135p/kg.

### 20 Cows & Stock Bulls sold to average 105p/kg

A really good trade but extremely short on numbers. Continental cows to 128p/kg for 674kg with Limousins to 127p/kg at 630kg. 808kg bellied British Blue crosses to 119p/kg (£961.52). 842kg meat Holsteins sold to 110p/kg (£926.20). Fat 772kg Limousin cows to £910.96. 722kg Limousin stock bulls to 105p/kg and very lean.

### 155 Clean Cattle

38 steers sold to average 156p/kg. Handy butchers Limousins topped this section at 185p/kg. 634kg Limousin x Blues to 180p/kg from Dave and Mark Froggatt. 510kg Limousins to 178p/kg from Glyn Morris, with Limousins and Blondes 494kg and 448kg from Ray Bason and Paul Taylor respectively to 175p/kg. 560kg British Blue crosses to 174p/kg for 560kg from Pete Raybould. 762kg Blondes to £1226.82 from James Paddock, with 724kg grass Limousins to £1078.76 from Gerald Kincaid, with 8 others above £1000. Holstein steers were fairly ordinary selling to 124p/kg.

117 heifers sold to average 160p/kg with our average including several cows under 48 months which sold above 140p/kg on two occasions for Nigel Kinsey. 450kg Blondes topped the day at 195p/kg for Ray Bason, closely tailed by Glyn Morris' Blue at 194p/kg for 492kg. 478kg Blondes sold to 188p/kg from Goulburn Farms, with Ray Bason's 506kg Blonde to 187p/kg. 564kg Limousin x

Blues from Nigel Kinsey sold to 186p/kg (£1049.04). 642kg Limousins to £1142.76 from James Paddock who sold 3 others above £1000.

742kg Limousins to £1105.58 from David Preece. 568kg Blues to £1011.04 from Glyn Morris. Hereford x Friesians to 137p/kg from Ray Bason.

### 91 Young Bulls av. 154p/kg

Our entry included 22 Holsteins etc. 532kg and 520kg Limousins from Mulberry Homes sold to 180p/kg and 178p/kg. 560kg and 580kg Limousins to 178p/kg and 176p/kg from Ian Bebb. 548kg Blues to 177p/kg from Rob Morris, with 556kg and 506kg Blondes to 176p/kg and 175p/kg from Richard Parkes. 514kg Blues to 175p/kg from Brian Williams. Numerous others in the 170 pence's. Goulburn Farms sold to £1136.66 for 706kg.
