## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 178 Prime Cattle

A disappointing number forward, with the Bank holiday disrupting the natural flow of cattle! The worst sample of cattle forward this morning that have been penned for many weeks, but there was a very good trade on anything with meat. A number of cattle would have suited the store ring more than our 'red' market, but are all included in the average of 151p/kg.

Best quality steers and heifers for wholesaling and retailing alike were hard to find today – especially best shop beasts under 520kg live. Bullocks sold to 190p/kg and to a top price per head of £1066.58. Heifers topped at 195p/kg on two occasions to a high of £1083.60. More commercial cattle met similar returns but there was more Holstein and belly about here!

Many more Holstein bulls in a smaller entry. A very good trade with finish at a premium. Best Continentals to 176p/kg or £1112.16. Friesians sold to 148p/kg.

### 20 Cows & Stock Bulls Over 48 months

Trade a little easier in line with other centres. 574kg Angus cows to 124p/kg with another to 123p/kg for 494kg. 676kg Charolais to 104p/kg with belly. 820kg meat Holsteins sold to 95p/kg (£779). Lean steakers from 85-94p/kg. Boners were very plain and recently milked sold to 75p/kg. Holstein stock bulls 1216kg sold to 90p/kg (£1094.40)

### 110 Clean Cattle

Only 31 steers sold to average 154p/kg and included 10 Holsteins (one over 30 months, one 88p/kg!). A tremendous run from Dave & Mark Froggatt sold to 190p/kg for 554kg and 180p/kg for 580kg. Other 606kg Limousins from Gerald Kincaid sold to 176p/kg, with handy 484kg to 175p/kg from Pete Raybould, 520kg Limousins from Arthur Hill sold to 174p/kg. Holstein steers sold to 133p/kg.

79 heifers sold to average 158p/kg. Blondes from Bill Aston flew in the ring to make 195p/kg, 189p/kg and 189p/kg for 444kg, 460kg and 444kg respectively. Slightly sharper Limousins from George Evans sold to 195p/kg, 190p/kg and 189p/kg (x2) for 508kg, 554kg, 496kg and 472kg. 480kg Limousins to 186p/kg from Richard Morgan. 553kg Blondes to 184p/kg from Sue Evans. 536kg and 486kg Blue crosses to 183p/kg from Robert Jones. Herefords to 132p/kg for Bill Aston's handyweights.

## 68 Young Bulls ov. av. 140p/kg

Our average includes 36 Holstein/Friesian bulls. Mrs Burgoyne sold 540kg Limousins to 176p/kg to top the section, with a superb 662kg Blonde to £1112.16 from Martin Osborne. A super run of heavies from Glyn Breeze sold to £1065 from 750kg and £1048.28 for 718kg all Limousin crosses. 628kg Limousins to 166p/kg from John Griffiths.

Dave Evans' Friesians topped the black and white section at 148p/kg and 147p/kg, with Geoff Hotchkiss and Roger Rowson selling to 139p/kg. Overall average 128p/kg including some 101p specials!

## **SALE REPORT**

### **DOWNTON ESTATE – SATURDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST**

On Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2009, an on farm sale of sheep at Brakes Farm was held on behalf of Downton Estates, the first sale for 104 years when in 1905 the Stonebrook herd of Hereford cows were sold under the hammer.

The Brakes Farm buildings provided an idyllic backdrop, with 3260 lambs penned and presented by shepherd Anthony Watts and his team of keen 'advisors'!

The sale attracted interested from far and wide however, more sheep were purchased by local customers from surrounding counties.

The 3260 lambs averages £55.40, selling to £74.50 for Suffolk x North Country Mule ewe lambs. 1459 Texel Wether Lambs, virtually all in store condition to £62.50, 263 Suffolk x North Country Mule Store Lambs to £59.20. 295 Suffolk ewe lambs to £74.50 and 1250 Texel x Ewe Lambs to £68
