Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

229 Prime Cattle

Trade a little easier especially on the plainer bulls, with a very mixed entry penned this morning consisting of some very good cattle and some 'storey' types needing more time and/or feed. An overall average of 149p/kg resulted with one buyer missing and reporting that there are plenty of cattle available at the moment? However, there was plenty of competition around the ring especially on well finished shapely sorts which easily held values.

A very poor entry of steers consisted of a large proportion of Hereford crosses, all lean and over 30 months. Best steers sold to 179p/kg or £1052.70- there were very few yard fed beasts in this department. Butchers heifers met the customary firm trade selling to 195p/kg or £1054.62.

Bull trade proved a little more difficult with plenty of plainer Holsteins forward at the moment. Best Continentals were thin on the ground but sold to 171p/kg for handyweights. Top price per head of £1077.12. Well finished Friesians sold to 144p/kg.

19 Cows & 2 Stock Bulls over 48 months

Plenty of competition for numbers forward saw best British Blue cows to 137p/kg for 642kg, with Limousins to 120p/kg for 628kg. Meat Friesians were not the very best but sold to 99p/kg for 632kg. Steakers sold to 96p/kg for Holsteins and boners to 75p/kg.

Limousin stock bulls to 106p/kg for 926kg and an ultra lean model to 93p/kg for 792kg.

153 Clean Cattle

28 steers sold to average 147p/kg. 538kg Blondes sold to a high of 179p/kg for Martin Mottershead, with grass Limousins to 165p/kg for 638kg from Gerald Kincaid. 512kg Blondes to 161p/kg from Sam Swinnerton, with two Continentals from Paul Taylor to 160p/kg for 584kg and 566kg. Red Herefords off pastures sold to 142p/kg from Brockencote House, indoor reds to 144p/kg for Mr Taylor and a large run of 8 Hereford x Holsteins all over 32 months sold to 115p/kg but lacked meat. Holstein bullocks to 119p/kg.

MORE WELL MEATED BULLOCKS NEEDED

125 heifers sold to average 158p/kg. Heifer trade was generally unaffected with some middle of the road beasts a dearer trade. Bill Morgan's handy 418kg Blue sold to 195p/kg, with another from Michael Williams' stable to 191p/kg for 478kg. 190p/kg was achieved by both George

Evans and the Williams' for 554kg Limousins and 506kg Blues respectively. Bob Beaman's Blonde hit 189p/kg for 524kg, with George Evans and Roger Jordin selling Limousins to the same for 558kg and 490kg. 536kg Limousins to 188p/kg from Neil Perkins. Plenty of others sold in the 180p bracket. Hereford heifers to 150p/kg.

78 Young Bulls av. 142p/kg

There are 28 Holsteins/Friesians in this Tuesday's entry. Handier weight bulls proved the order of the day, with 454kg and 478kg selling to 171p/kg and 165p/kg for Limousins from Mrs Burgoyne. 554kg Limousin x Blues from Glynn Breeze sold to 169p/kg. 584kg and 576kg Limousins from George Evans and Mulberry Homes both achieved 167p/kg. Barrow Farms' bulls sold to £1077.12 with many other vendors selling above £1000.

David Evans topped the black and white department at 144p/kg and 137p/kg. Clive Bunning's Holsteins sold to 137p/kg. Overall Holstein average 124p/kg.

An improved entry and trade firmer although the overall average of 144p/kg would be very similar to last week. However, this week's average included several large lean ram lambs and a much heavier show of lambs. Several pens broke the £70 barrier to £72.16 with 46.5kg at 147p/kg. Highest price per kilo for 36 to 42 kilos selling to 165p/kg from HA Bunning & Son. 12 pens made 150p/kg or more.

Very few light lambs this week, the lightest being 32kg and 142p/kg.

More lambs under 34kg will be required for next week with the month of ramadan drawing to a close.
