## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### **200 Prime Cattle**

Cattle actually sold to average more per kilo today with a much poorer sample of beasts forward. An overall average of 148p/kg resulted, with best quality cattle easily maintaining values. The normal ring of buyers attended, with plenty of competition on all qualities of cattle.

Only a handful of steers with little shape forward sold to 173p/kg or £966.64 per head. Butchers heifers were a firm trade throughout selling to 193p/kg to £1052.16. Many bad percenting second string types met reasonable returns, with overfat cattle heavily penalised.

A mixed bull sample with a strong Holstein entry, with the best suckler bulls quite often on the heavy side over 700kg. Well finished Friesian bulls sold to 136p/kg. Heavy sucklers to £1195.84 per head.

### **51 Cows & 2 over 48mth steers sold to average 78p/kg**

The worst sample of cows for sometime with the largest majority of the entry plain boning and a few steaking cows.

572kg Friesian steers sold to 116p/kg. 624kg meat Blonde cows sold to 101p/kg with 658kg and 742kg Limousin cows to 100p/kg and 99p/kg. 702kg meat Holsteins to 98p/kg. All cows with a lick of meat sold to a trade in advance of Monday reports. Boning cows in plentiful supply sold from 35p/kg-70p/kg generally. Fat Herefords to 98p/kg x 3 up to 738kg.

### **107 Clean Cattle**

21 steers sold to average 144p/kg. Handy weight 494kg and 564kg Limousins from John Woolrich sold to 173p/kg and 170p/kg. Blondes from Mr England sold to 172p/kg or £966.64- all the above yard fed. 540kg Simmental crosses from Phillip Roberts sold to 164p/kg. 618kg non FABBL Herefords to 141p/kg from Brockencote House Farm Partnership (£902.16).

86 heifers sold to average 157p/kg. 488kg Limousins topped the day at 193p/kg from George Evans. 548kg and 514kg Blondes from Richard Parkes sold to 192p/kg and 190p/kg respectively (£1052.16 for the former). 448kg Limousins from Steve Perkins sold to 190p/kg with Jean Kirkham's 474kg black Limousin to 188p/kg. 524kg Limousins to 187p/kg from Ben Rochelle. 530kg Limousins to 186p/kg from Roger Jordin. Neil Dalton, Jean Kirkham and Ed Green (x2) all sold to 185p/kg with

Dalton's 542kg Blonde eventually realising £1002.70. Nigel Kinsey Blonde sold to £1044.42.

### **94 Young Bulls av. 141p/kg**

Our entry included 25 Holstein/Friesian and 8 Hereford cross Holsteins.

Eddie Thomas' 548kg Limousin topped this section at 170p/kg, with Mike Williams' 3 Limousins 166p/kg x 2 and 165p/kg all handy weights. 576kg Limousins to 168p/kg from Mulberry Homes, with 616kg Limousins and 560kg Blues to 167p/kg from Craig Evans and Glynn Morris respectively. Lots pf heavy bulls forward sold to a fair trade with 808kg Limousins to £1195.84 from Nigel Matthews and another 678kg to £1118.70 from the same stable. 800kg from John Hewitt sold to £1144 with 738kg Limousins from George Evans to £1084.86. More bulls selling above £1000 today.

Roger Rowson's well-rounded Friesians sold to 136p/kg and 135p/kg with plainer Friesians a little less valuable averaging 120p/kg including 108p/kg 'specials'.
