A larger entry of bulls but a shortage of clean cattle met a similar trade, with the best cattle buoyant and second string types more difficult. An overall average of 147p/kg resulted with plenty of competition on the bulls and the clean sections. The average price per head of clean cattle £810.46.

Very few supermarket spec cattle forward with most steers under 600kg. Steers sold to 180p/kg or £1058.76. Butchers heifers especially under 520kg sold to a dearer trade to 205p/kg, with two others 200p/kg plus. £1109.60 was the top amount received for heifers today. Overfat, ultra lean, shapeless sorts are meeting a lack lustre trade as the 'meat men' report slow trading.
