## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 121 Prime Cattle

A very useful pre-Christmas entry of cattle considering the terrible road conditions making travelling difficult for all concerned. A very dear trade resulted with producers who braved the wintry conditions well rewarded. An overall average of 161p/kg resulted with all the regular abattoir buyers represented around the ring.

Clean cattle with meat in strong demand, with strong competition seeing steers to 196p/kg or £1118.88. Butchers heifers sold to 209p/kg with a top price per head of £1097.36. An overall clean average of 165p/kg represents an equivalent deadweight price of at least 300p/kg on all steers and heifers whatever weight or grade.

An exceptional bull trade saw Continentals selling past 180p/kg to a high of 189p/kg or £1172.90. Friesian-Holsteins looked as well sold as any selling to 157p/kg and 155p/kg.

17 steers sold to an overall average of 168p/kg. Quality Blue cross and Limousin steers from Dave Awre met a flying trade selling to 196p/kg, 189p/kg and 188p/kg for 540kg and 592kg and 582kg, closely followed by Steve Perkins' Limousin at 183p/kg. 634kg Limousins from Dave Chilton selling to 176p/kg. Red Hereford steers to 160p/kg.

70 heifers sold to overall average of 162p/kg. Mr Awre in the pound seat here also selling 502kg and 506kg Blue/Limousin crosses to 209p/kg and 201p/kg and 442kg Blondes to 191p/kg. 486kg Limousins to 200p/kg from Steve Perkins, with 512kg Limousins to 191p/kg

from Ray Bason. 504kg Limousins to 190p/kg from David Chilton. Numerous others and not necessarily the very best sold above 175p/kg. Ordinary cattle very dear mostly above 140p/kg

### 34 Young Bulls ov. av 156p/kg

More bulls are needed on this trade with 16 Holsteins in the entry. Dave Awre's shapely Continentals sold to 189p/kg and 186p/kg for 554kg and 588kg. 634kg and 534kg Limousins and Blondes to 185p/kg and 180p/kg.

Roger Rowson's Holsteins topped the black and white department at 157p/kg for 562kg with 642kg to 155p/kg from Bob Mayer. Gilbert Brown's 560kg Holstein to 153p/kg. Plain Holsteins very dear – 130p plus!

The best trade for lambs for a very long time averaging 215p/kg, with only one pen of heavy lambs under £2/kg to a top price per kilo of 243p/kg and plenty realising £90 and over. Even 47kg lambs over £2/kg to 209p/kg for 46kg. One consignment of lambs from Roger Swift averaged 40kg and 227p/kg.

Light weights 29kg to 211p/kg, with one customer's lambs 490p/kg deadweight with all costs to add on. Why sell lambs any other way then liveweight now that supply is dictating price?
