## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 201 Prime Cattle

Some winter weather greeted us this morning making travelling on by-roads particularly awkward and with some producers deciding to stop at home, a slightly reduced number were forward. Those that did brave the snow and ice were well rewarded with a very satisfactory trade on all types of cattle. An overall average of 158p/kg resulted reflected an upturn in values. There were new orders for cattle, with heavy snowfalls creating a shortfall in supplies of beasts especially in the North.

A few more quality sorts in the heifer and steer department but with fewer handy-weights saw steers selling to 187p/kg and heifers to 193p/kg. Clean cattle of all shapes and sizes sold well above dead quotations for this week.

Bull trade was very dear and saw a thin scattering of suckler bulls selling to 179p/kg. Friesians sold to 161p/kg. Holsteins sold to 152p/kg.

### 18 Cows & Stock Bulls av.97p/kg

A firmer trade with young cows to 119p/kg for 704kg Herefords. 776kg Simmental cows to 114p/kg. No best Holsteins forward saw 776kg to 93p/kg. Hereford stock bulls 1124kg to 101p/kg.

### 124 Clean Cattle

Only 19 steers sold to average 163p/kg. A cracking run of Blues and Blondes from Roy Kinnish sold to 187p/kg for 528kg, with 604kg and 578kg to 182p/kg and 181p/kg respectively. 606kg Blondes from Martin Mottershead to 186p/kg. 526kg Blues from Keith Tolley to 181p/kg. 564kg Limousins to 177p/kg from Neil Dalton

105 heifers sold to average 163p/kg. Roy Kinnish topped this section also at 193p/kg and 191p/kg for 502kg and 432kg Blondes. A superb run of Limousins from John Evans sold to 191p/kg for two at 508kg, with 520kg and 502kg to 190p/kg. 478kg Limousins to 189p/kg from Mark Pinches. Many others sold above 180p/kg. More commercial cattle very dear in places.

### 78 Young Bulls ov. av 150p/kg

Our entry included 40 Holsteins & Friesians. Top price was 179p/kg which was achieved by Sam Swinnerton's 526kg British Blue and Mulberry Homes' 570kg Limousin. 544kg Limousins sold to 178p/kg from IGC Morris. Mulberry Homes' Blonde sold to 177p/kg for 632kg. 582kg Blue x Friesians to 177p/kg also from the Morris stable. 566kg Angus crosses to 171p/kg from Dave Preece.

Best Friesians sold to 161p/kg for 524kg from Henry Yates. Holsteins to 152p/kg from Tom Hill. Black and Whites averaged 139p/kg.
