Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

196 Prime Cattle

A very mixed trade and a very varied entry of bulls and clean cattle. Clean cattle sold above last week's values but with ordinary bulls a very awkward trade. Only one regular buyer was missing around the ring today, with a strong butcher contingent who competed strongly on the best cattle. Butchers heifers sold to 200p/kg and steers 183p/kg. Quality clean cattle were harder to find this week, with more beasts forward best suited for the store ring.

Bull trade was limited to the best well finished handy weights, with heavier types or Holsteins suffering a fall. Continentals sold to 163p/kg.

22 Cows & Stock Bulls

A marked realignment of values here also, saw meat cows to 93p/kg and stock bulls to 96p/kg.

114 Clean Cattle

43 steers sold to average 147p/kg. 600kg Limousin from Steve Perkins sold to 183p/kg (£1098), closely followed by a 594kg Limousin from Neil Perkins realising 181p/kg. Handy weight 514kg Blondes from Brian Watkins sold to 175p/kg. 558kg from Harold Pugh sold to 172p/kg. Neil Preece's 688kg sold to £1128.32.

71 heifers sold to average just short of 150p/kg. Bob Beaman's Blondes and Limousins sold to 200p/kg and 192p/kg for 498kg and 476kg respectively. A tidy run of Limousins from Mark Pinnock sold to 189p/kg, 187p/kg and 185p/kg all 438kg to 492kg. Richard Morgan's 'feisty females' topped at 188p/kg for 530kg, with several in the 180 pence's.

82 Young Bulls ov. av. 130p/kg

Our entry included 39 Holstein/Friesians. Handy Limousin x Friesians at 548kg topped at 163p/kg from Dave Evans, with heavier bulls 644kg Charolais and 656kg Limousin both to 162p/kg for Dave Brick and Murray Roberts respectively. 766kg shapely bulls also from the Brick stable realised £1194.96. 128p/kg was the best we could do in the Holstein/Friesian department today!

A market average of 195p/kg, with best 36kg to 42kg lambs nothing short of an exceptional trade selling to 252p/kg for 35kg Charollais lambs from Richard Ince and Richard Cotham's 48kg Texels over £100 to £102.30 or 238p/kg. The hattrick of 'Richards' was completed by Richard Morgan whose 50.5kg lambs to 199p/kg or £100.50.

Lighter weights sold to just short of 200p/kg, with 32kg at 198p/kg and 27.5kg at 197p/kg.

To maintain this level of buoyant support, more lambs will be required every week with finished lambs attracting the higher prices per kilo.
