### 212 Clean Cattle (including show)

54 steers sold to average 151p/kg. Top price beast not winning a rosette went to 'a very deserving cause', with his 502kg British Blue selling to 201p/kg. 548kg Limousins sold 179p/kg from Mike Williams, with 636kg Limousins to 178p/kg from Alistair Beedles (£1132.08). 542kg Limousins to 171p/kg from Ray Bason. 720kg Blondes to £1188 from Frank Millichamp, with Charolais from Richard Preece to £1120.14. Several others sold above £1000.

158 heifers sold to average 153p/kg. Some superb handy weight Blues and Limousins from Mike Williams sold to 211p/kg, 201p/kg and 193p/kg for 464kg, 470kg and 442kg, with heavier 596kg and 560kg Blues to 191p/kg from the same home. 488kg Blues from Richard Morgan sold to 195p/kg. 474kg Limousins to 186p/kg from Arthur Hill. 526kg Charolais also realised Rob Hartley 186p/kg, with Graham Poyner's 574kg Blue to 185p/kg. Several others sold to 180p/kg.

### 111 Young Bulls ov av 140p/kg

40 Holstein/Friesians are included in our entry. A slightly easier trade with many heavy bulls forward this morning.

Handy-weights from Mike Williams once again sold to 178p/kg for 476kg Blonde, with 594kg to 171p/kg for Ed Green's Limousin. Mulberry Homes sold 628kg and 606kg Limousins and Blues to 168p/kg and 167p/kg, with 598kg to 167p/kg for Andrew Craig. Steve Perkins' Limousin 590kg sold to 166p/kg. 780kg Limousins sold to £1170 from John White, with Dave Brick's 724kg Blues cross to £1086.00. Trade easier on very large bulls generally.

Holstein/Friesian trade no dearer selling to a high of 144p/kg from Terry Davies, with Roger Beaumont selling to 138p/kg. All black and whites averaged 125p/kg.

### 27 Cows & 1 Stock Bull

A 'snorting' trade and more cows are desperately required to satisfy demand. Several cows will hang up dear than 'clean cattle' today.

718kg Limousin cows sold to 129p/kg (£926.22) from Mr Hughes, with Dan Powell's 754kg Simmental realising £957.58 (127p/kg) and his 670kg Simmental realising 129p/kg also. Meat Holsteins a flying trade selling to 127p/kg for 714kg from Adrian Robinson, with Holsteins to £923.44 and £906.78 from the same stable. 1070kg Holstein stock bulls to 90p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst. **More cows required.**

The largest entry of hoggs this year and despite trade being easier on Monday trade held firm at Bridgnorth to average 190p/kg selling well over 200p/kg to 243p/kg for 41.5kg Texels from Andrew Meredith

Well fleshed Continentals 38kg to 43kg over 200p/kg notably 213p/kg to 235p/kg from Ian Morris. Heavier sheep dearer than last week although quality much better this week to £100.85, with 46.5kg to 186p/kg, 52.5kg at 172.5p/kg and 58kg to 160p/kg.

Light weights remain sought after to 180p/kg for 32kg Welsh, Continental 35kg to 191p/kg. More light hoggs could be sold every week with regular orders for 200 plus.

Only 19 spring lambs for the show, sponsored by Farmers Guardian, a reflection of the early Easter and poor weather conditions. However, first prize went to Derek Rowley for his 32.5kg lambs at 268p/kg purchased by John Rutter. The 19 lambs averaged 257p/kg to £100.04.
