## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 307 Prime Cattle

A very good number forward this morning met a very similar trade with all bulls and clean averaging 143p/kg all through. With numbers of cattle out everywhere in recent weeks, prices are holding well although not at levels comparable in the store ring!

Lean, shape and good fleshing was the order of the day, with bad percenting and/or fat clean cattle hard to sell. Steers sold to 165p/kg and to a high of £1085.76, with many over thirty month bullocks forward. Heifers sold to 213p/kg and 201p/kg for handy butchers' cattle, with heavy heifers realising up to £1111.80. Plenty of OTMs in the female section also.

Out of specification bulls were less money today, with many prepared to buy bulls over 18 months old but needing them at less money. Best shop bulls sold to 174p/kg, with shapely heavy British Blues to 175p/kg and over weights to £1220.10.

### 23 Cows & 2 Stock Bulls

Trade very good in this section and more cows are urgently required. 666kg Limousin cows to 134p/kg, with 770kg Blondes to 129p/kg and 712kg Charolais to 126p/kg. There were no best meat Holsteins forward but lean steakers sold to 96p/kg, with plain boners past 65p/kg selling to 80p/kg. Holstein stock bulls to 100p/kg with Shorthorns to 93p/kg.

It is quite amazing how regular customers feel the need to go to other centres with cows and OTM cattle when the competition is so obviously strong at Bridgnorth. We advise you to look at the weight of your cattle and the commission you are being charged, before vacating Bridgnorth with cows.

### 227 Clean Cattle

57 steers sold to average 144p/kg. Dave Chilton sold Lims to 165p/kg for 590kg, with two Lim x Blues to 164p/kg for 606kg and 588kg from Dave Froggatt. 652kg Limousins from Gordon Jones also sold to 164p/kg. 466kg handy Blonde from Ben & Sam Rochelle sold to 163p/kg, with 564kg Limousins to 159p/kg. Small Holstein steers to 118p/kg, with Herefords to 129p/kg.

170 heifers sold to average 146p/kg. The Chilton stable had successful runners here also with super Limousin crosses to 213p/kg and 201p/kg for 454kg and 428kg. 512kg Blues from Andrew Dalton 'kicked on' to 186p/kg,

with Bill Morgan and Goulburn Farms both achieving 185p/kg for their handy weights. 542kg Blues to 185p/kg Roger Jordin. A cracking 654kg Blonde from Martin Osborne realised £1118.80 at 170p/kg.

### 80 Young Bulls ov av 138p/kg

Our entry included 26 Holstein/Friesian bulls. A superb 566kg British Blue from Neil Perkins topped at 175p/kg, closely followed by Tim Madeley's 512kg Limousin at 174p/kg. Andrew Craig sold Limousins to 170p/kg at 518kg, with 632kg to 168p/kg from Goulburn Farms. 830kg Limousins realised £1220.10 from Malcolm Jones. Several others realised £1000 plus, with heavy bull carcasses proving a little less saleable at the moment.

Friesians sold to 143p/kg and 139p/kg from Dave Evans, with Charlie Lloyd selling to 138p/kg. Black and whites averaged 121p/kg including 99p/kg 'specials'.

A very ordinary show of steers and heifers, with a lovely run of Charolais suckler bulls from JJC Coldwell providing the highlight of the sale. Obviously, with prime prices curbing enthusiasm a slightly easier trade resulted- although quality sorts still proved in strong demand. Simmental steers sold to £822 or £222 over their weight, with heifers to £770 or £294 over. Bulls sold to £762 or £302 over their weight.
