## Prime Cattle Report (Red Market)

### 296 Prime Cattle

A similar trade to last week, with overall averages just struggling to hold above 140p/kg. Quality lean clean cattle sold easily once again, with over fat beasts not really required. It must be noted that several cattle (bulls especially) that are not required by supermarket abattoirs because of age or size are presented in the live ring and all of these found homes and are included in the average.

Butchers heifers and steers found, as usual, plenty of competition, with females to 190p/kg or £1075.80. A fair bullock trade saw quality cattle to 183p/kg or £1079.10. Over fat or non FABBL plain sorts would adversely affect the averages.

A decent show of bulls saw a steady trade with fewer Holsteins forward, as suckler bulls come 12-14 months and ready for sale. Top price of 169p/kg or £1,157.12 per head. The Holsteins still look a fair go against the others.

### 34 Cows & Stock Bulls ov av 105p/kg

A firm trade here once again with plenty of competition for the goods. 790kg Saler crosses sold to 125p/kg (£987.50), with young 578kg cows to the same. 622kg Limousins to 124p/kg. Meat Holsteins were full of belly today around the 95p/kg-100p/kg realising up to £863.30. 1064kg Limousin stock bulls to 106p/kg.

### 202 Clean Cattle

60 steers sold to overall average of 145p/kg. 566kg, 546kg & 606kg British Blue crosses sold to 183p/kg, 177p/kg and 170p/kg all from Neil Preece. 522kg Limousins to 179p/kg from Alice & Mike Williams. 486kg Limousins to 170p/kg from John Woolrich. 570kg Limousins to 166p/kg from Dave Chilton, with Dave Froggatt selling to 165p/kg and £1079.10 for a 654kg Limousin cross Blue. 758kg Charolais to £1038.46 for Ted Rogers. 756kg Charolais to £1013.04 for Mrs Parker who also sold Friesians to 115p/kg.

142 heifers sold to an overall average 146p/kg. Jean Kirkham topped the day at 190p/kg for her 462kg Limmo closely followed at 188p/kg by other Lims from Mike Williams, Roger Jordin & George Evans. Handy 392kg models to 186p/kg from Dave Chilton, with 498kg Lims to 186p/kg from Steve Perkins. Numerous others exceeded 180p/kg with Dave Preece and Dave Froggatt selling above £1000. There is little wrong with the trade

for best heifers generally!

### 95 Young Bulls ov av 136p/kg

16 Holsteins and one OTM bull are included in the above averages. 3 nice Limousins from Andrew Craig sold to 169p/kg for 545kg closely followed by Goulburn Farms' 510kg Blue at 168p/kg. 648kg & 600kg Limousins hit 163p/kg and 160p/kg respectively from Ian Bebb. Frank Povall and Mike Williams also sold above 160p/kg. Heavy 904kg Limousins from John Hewitt sold to £1157.12. No best black & whites forward saw Friesians to 128p/kg from Dave Chilton and Holsteins to 126p/kg from Malcolm Dodd. 82p/kg 'specials' are included in the averages.

One of the largest entries this year sold to an easier trade in line with Monday, with best hoggs falling just short of 200p/kg, Texels to 195p/kg from Nigel Kinsey.

As you would expect at this time of year, quality was very mixed with a weight range from 24kg to 84kg. Heavy hoggs to £91 and light weight hoggs to 185p/kg, with some poor lean hoggs forward.

**905 Spring Lambs**

Spring lambs averaged 231p/kg, a few pence dearer than Monday. Best lambs sold over 240p/kg to 264p/kg for Texels from Pete Kirton, with lean shapely lambs most sought after both for the export and supermarket trade.

For the second week, lambs realised over £100 per head to £103.74 for 45.5kg at 228p/kg from Richard Tate.

Very few light lambs to 240p/kg for 32kg.
