Trade: Another pleasing trade with reported prices advanced on other centres. Suckler bred Herefords from Alan Redout (10 m.o.) sold to a cracking £550, whilst Continental crosses (7 m.o.) from the same vendor, David Holland and Andrew Gale raced to £542. 15 m.o. types to a grand £790 from the Late Neil Rimington, whose Hereford heifers of the same age pushed on to £640. Other good entries also from Lennie Gould. Dairy bred stores sold well with John Hooper's yearling Limousins taking the eye at £540, whilst tidy sorts from Les Ings and the Hannam family pushed on to £690.
