A slightly reduced entry of lambs, This being coupled with the talk of breaking weather and the trade in general having eased. 1890 lambs were forward and leveled at 158.5p/kg. Light lambs peaked at 179p/kg with 29kg lambs from D G Jones & Partners Cefnhirfawr making £51.00 with the overall average being 167.5p/kg. Standard lambs peaked at 174p/kg from M I & T E M Pritchard Rhydwith with 38kg lambs fetching £66.00 the standards averaged 154.5p/kg. As always the medium lambs were in very good demand with many buyers strongly contending for them. Topping the days trade was A R & E M Evison Ty Gwyn with 43.5kg lambs hitting £82.50 or 190p/kg the mediums leveled at 158.5p/kg. The heavy lambs again were in good demand with 3 buyers bidding strongly at lambs from £75 - £80 per head.
