Superlights to 160p average 157.5p. Light Lambs averaged 161p peaking at 174p with 31kg Lambs fetching £54 from T S & M A Morgan Glanhafon Fach. Standard Lambs were in much stronger demand averaging 158p up some 8p on the week. S G & M G Pritchard Stone House topped the section with 38kg Lambs making £63 at 166p/kg. The Medium Lambs leveled at 157.5p topping at 165p with 42kg Lambs making £69.20 from G G & N A Rees Highfields. The Heavy Lambs topped at £77.50 from S Jones 8 Y Ddol and averaged 152p.
